

Antler pens

In the course of history of writing instruments a man has been using various materials to make pens. Reed, bird feathers, bone, ivory, etc. Elk and deer antlers are no exception.

Antler pens are marvelous gifts. If you are looking for a great gift for a hunter, sportsman, or outdoorsman, for Christmas, in case of graduation or on some other memorable occasion, an antler pen will probably be the best choice. In most cases they are truly handcrafted by skillful craftsmen. Each pen is a work of art. Of course, duplicating machines can be used in order to produce more pens a day, but this is not what is really valued about antler pens. In most cases there's one pen at a time, what makes no two pens quite alike, what makes antler pens a real boon for serious collectors.

Antler pens can be available as ballpoint pens, rollerball pens and, of course, fountain pens. All models are famous for their longevity, as they are hand-made of the finest materials and fittings. The following types of hardware are generally used: platinum, titanium, gold standard, gold plate, etc. The platinum hardware looks stunning with the natural antler. Moreover, it is extremely durable. Titanium hardware has special plating offering the durability of titanium with the richness and color similar to 24k gold. Gold hardware is 22k gold plated and is really unique as a small amount of cobalt is usually added during the plating process, what makes the surface extremely wear resistant.

And finally, many handcraftsmen include a guarantee to their creations (of one, two years or even lifelong), like big name pen manufacturers do (Mont Blanc, Parker, Waterman, etc.).
